Whisked by private speedboat from Malé, discover the charm of a Maldivian village on a private coral island in the turquoise sea. Palm-thatched pavilions and bungalows line the white sand or rise above the crystal water. A spa on an island of its own offers soothing Asian secrets. Sunrise, sunshine and sunset paint the endless sky.



Four Seasons Resort Maldives at Kuda Huraa is a private island haven of 96 bungalows – 38 poised above the lagoon, 57 with their own pools nestled along the beach, and an expansive Royal Beach Villa. The exotic village-like atmosphere of the 4.86-hectare (12-acre) island resort – aglow with the blossoms of bougainvillea, bird of paradise and frangipani – creates a social environment. Yet Kuda Huraa makes it easy to get away. The Island Spa is a serene hideaway on its own island, just a minute away from the Resort by *dhoni* (native Maldivian wooden boat).

The Resort's three restaurants and two lounges offer inspired options to suit any taste, with Indian cuisine, Italian fare and Asian-influenced menus, as well as lighter choices. For intimate business events or personal celebrations, the 45-square-metre (484-square-foot) Library hosts receptions for 30, banquets for 20 or conferences for 14 around the boardroom table.

Opportunities for adventure abound with diving, sailing, snorkelling and water sports, all within reach. Those seeking a quieter pace can enjoy peaceful lounging by the large freshwater pool, which seems to merge with the blue horizon, while attendants offer a refreshing spritz or chilled towel.

Many guests choose to experience the diversity of the Maldives by pairing their visit with a stay at Four Seasons Resort Maldives at Landaa Giraavaru, a hideaway of wild natural beauty.

Four Seasons Explorer

Guests can enhance their stay on Kuda Huraa with a three-, four- or seven-night cruise on the Four Seasons Explorer, a private three-deck, 11-cabin catamaran. Aboard the Explorer, you can stop for beach-side barbecues on remote island shores, fish or visit rarely seen diving and snorkelling sites.

Housed in Four Seasons comfort, Explorer guests enjoy such on-board amenities as a fully equipped PADI dive centre with Nitrox, two sundecks, including one with a whirlpool, massage by a qualified massage therapist, a restaurant and bar and even laundry service. An onboard marine biologist is available to offer insights into this delicate ecosystem.

TRANSPORTATION

Malé International Airport is served by a number of international and charter airlines, including Air Europe, Air India, Austrian Airlines, Bangkok Airways, Britannia Airways, British Airways, Condor Airlines, Edelweiss Air, Emirates Air, Eurofly, LTU International Airways, Malaysian Airlines, Martinair, Monarch Airways, Singapore Airlines, Sri Lankan Airlines and Qatar Airways.

Visitors must possess a passport valid for a minimum of six (6) months and a return ticket. Most visitors are given a 30-day visitor's permit on arrival. Visitors should consult their local consulate for visa requirements.

Please note that alcohol cannot be brought into the country. Any liquor found will be held until the visitor's departure.

DESTINATION

A double string of 1,190 coral islands to the southwest of Sri Lanka, stretching north to just south of the equator, make up the Republic of Maldives. This archipelago in the Indian Ocean, 130 kilometres (81 miles) at its widest point and 820 kilometres (510 miles) in length, is also the flattest in the world, with the highest natural land less than 2.4 metres (8 feet) above sea level.

Grouped into 26 atolls – ring-shaped coral formations enclosing a lagoon, which provide a natural defence against wind and wave – the Maldives covers a total area of 859,000 square kilometres (331,661 square miles), yet only 1% of this is land. Not surprisingly, this aquatic nation is considered one of the top 10 diving spots in the world. With only 200 inhabited islands and an additional 98 islands developed exclusively as tourist resorts, tourism is the dominant support for the economy.

Malé is the capital of the Republic of Maldives, an island 2 kilometres (1.2 miles) long and 1 kilometre (0.6 mile) wide. Though built to the edge, Malé is clean and quaint, with markets, mosques and a maze of small streets that approximately 103,000 people call home. A pleasant 25-minute speedboat ride from Malé International Airport, visitors are welcomed to the enchanting island of Kuda Huraa, where Four Seasons awaits.

WEATHER

Throughout the year, the Maldives enjoys warm, humid weather made pleasant by constant sea breezes. By late November, exceptionally calm seas mark the beginning of the dry season, known as *iruvai*, which runs until April. The daytime high is around 30°C (86°F) year-round, dropping to about 25°C (77°F) in the evenings.

Guest Room Overview

Set back from the beach for privacy, yet offering easy access to it, Beach Pavilions with Pool are comfortable and spacious. Many can be linked with gates and verandas to create a larger shared compound for family or friends.

Sunrise and Sunset Beach Bungalows with Pool are private sanctuaries secluded among mature palms and tropical flowers. Each has a bathing pavilion with open-air shower courtyard. Around the large infinity plunge pool, a tropical garden is furnished with shaded daybed and *undholi* (wooden swing).

Set on sturdy columns above the brilliant waters of Kuda Huraa's tranquil lagoon, the Sunrise and Sunset Water Bungalows are roofed in Maldivian thatch, with teak floors and modern tropical furnishings. Windows offer unbroken views of the sea, even from the bathtub – which is complemented by a Maldivian open-air shower. Angled to be seen only from the sea, the veranda is perfect for private sunbathing. Steps lead to the lagoon –

a natural swimming pool.

Suites Overview

Beautiful Sunrise or Sunset Water Suites offer extensive outdoor living space, with wraparound views of the sea from floor-to-ceiling windows. Master bathrooms feature an open-air shower courtyard. A sofa bed in the separate living room with adjoining shower room provides flexibility for families.

Sunrise or Sunset Two-Bedroom Water Suites offer separate dressing areas, bathrooms and outdoor showers with each bedroom. Steps lead from the extensive private sundeck to a platform with sea access. Just adjacent to the small Reef Island, these quarters ensure additional privacy, with excellent snorkelling nearby.

The Royal Beach Villa epitomises beach-side comfort for families or those requiring extra space. Beside each bedroom is a dressing area and spacious outdoor garden shower. The Royal Beach Villa enjoys its own exclusive stretch of beach with sun lounges and a private gazebo set over the water, ideal for breakfast or sunset drinks.

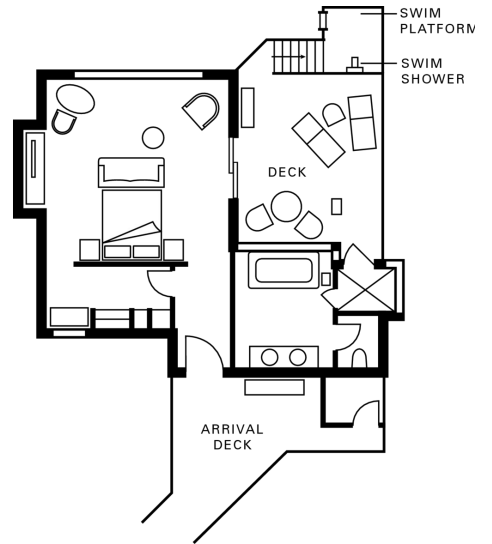

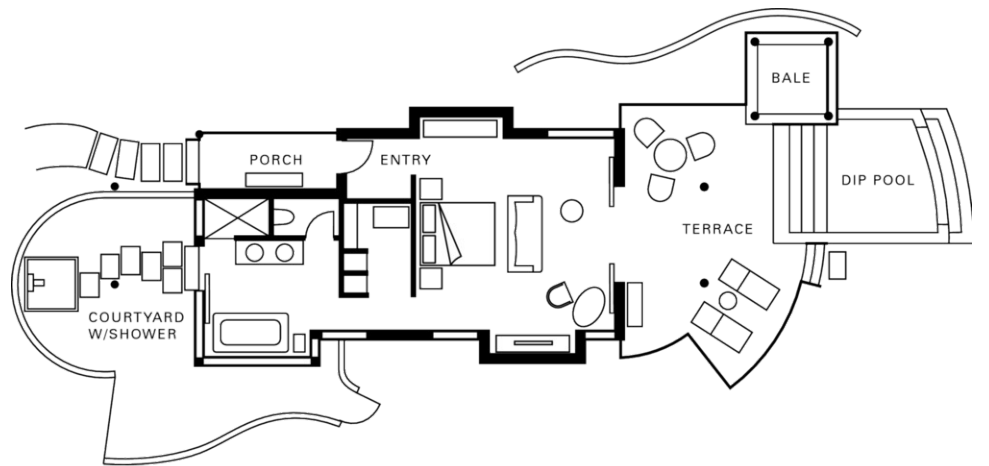

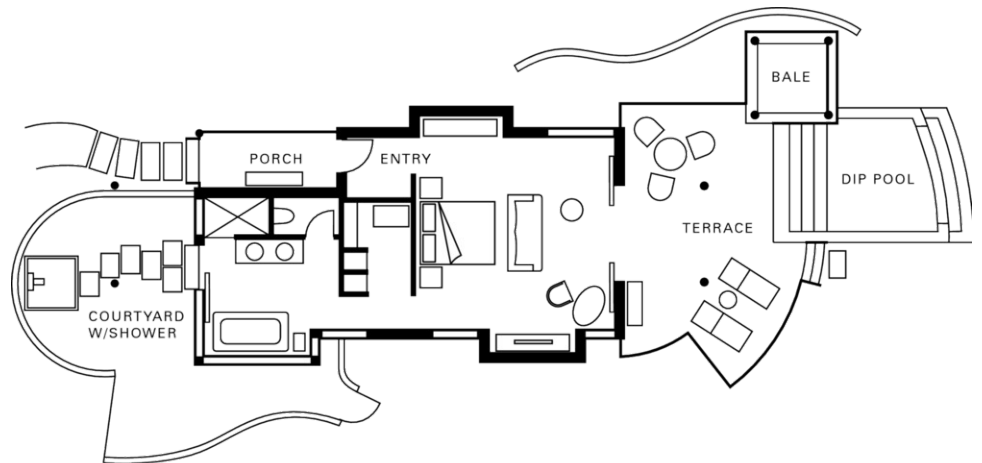

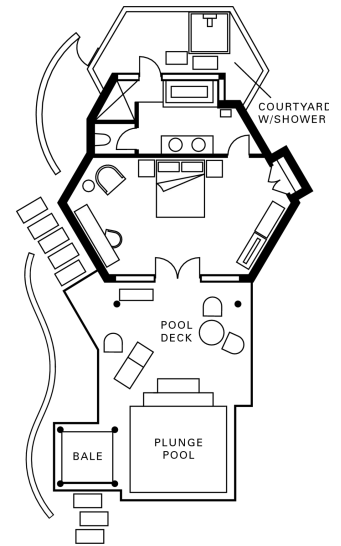

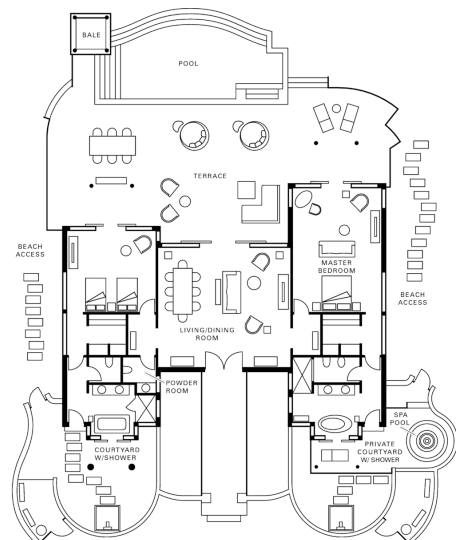

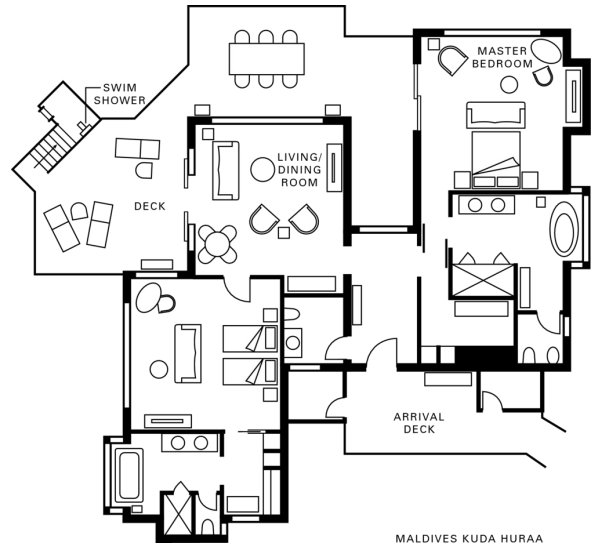

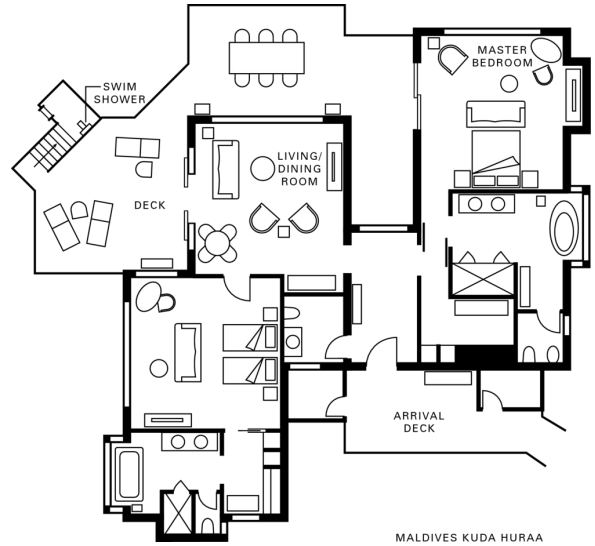

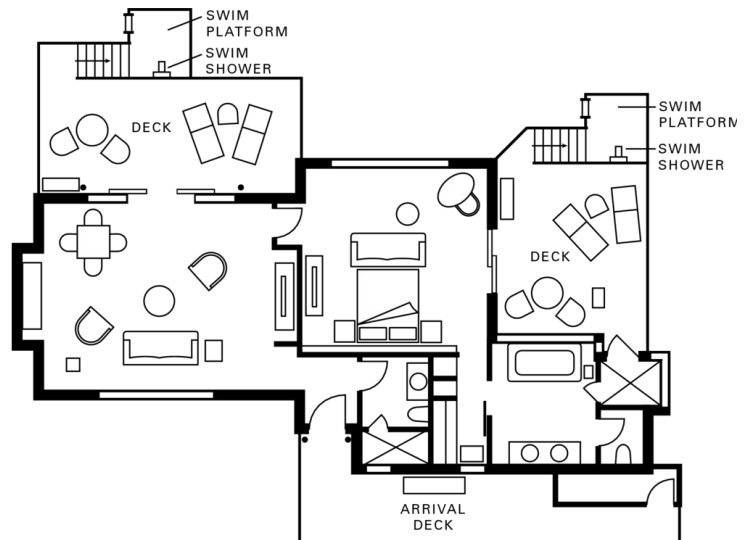

DINING

Dining at Four Seasons Resort Maldives at Kuda Huraa is an eclectic experience. Guests can savour fine Indian cuisine, celebrate the tastes of contemporary Italy or feast on Asian delicacies and choose from a cellar of handpicked fine wines. Natural settings inspire the palate and invite toasts to the magnificent Maldivian landscape – claim a seaside table, settle into a cafe pavilion, swim up to the poolside bar or sit perched above the lagoon on a torchlit terrace for an unforgettable meal.

Special arrangements can be made for beach picnics and sandbank dinners, Robinson Crusoe picnics, *dhoni* breakfasts and private parties of any size. Delicious In-Bungalow Dining is available 24 hours a day.

RESTAURANTS

Baraabaru

An elegant dinner at Baraabaru is a memorable affair. Guests may choose to dine in the restaurant's brightly coloured interiors, on the spectacular deck above the waters or in a private dining gazebo. The open kitchen features an open tandoori bar, where guests can watch as the chefs prepare fine Indian cuisine. The food is complemented by a wine list chosen to suit the tropics, with an emphasis on light wines and champagnes.

Sunset Lounge

Explore the water in every way with the help of the Dive Centre, Water Sports Centre and Surf School – or simply around the pool.

A children's pool and extensive Kuda Mas Kids' Club occupy our youngest guests. Spot colourful tropical fish from the boardwalks and jetty, hunt for seashells along the sandy shore of Kuda Huraa or visit the Recreation Centre to arrange engaging group activities, such as nature walks, marine lectures, fishing, island excursions, cooking classes or table tennis.

SPA SERVICES

A serene hideaway within a hideaway, the Island Spa at Four Seasons Resort Maldives at Kuda Huraa has its own island. Here, you can feel as one with the ocean – let the gentle rhythms of the earth soothe your senses, allowing cares and tensions to dissolve and wash away.

POOLS

Main Pool

With an infinity edge that seems to merge with the blue horizon, our freshwater swimming pool is one of the largest in the Maldives. Surrounded by a large sun deck, it features chaises longues for comfortable lounging. Attendants are ready to provide a fresh towel or a cooling spritz of mist. Pool service and a swim-up bar provides refreshments.

Children's Pool

An oval-shaped children's pool, adjacent to the main pool, overlooks the ocean. At Kuda Huraa, unforgettable land and water diversions beckon. The Water Sports Centre offers a wide range of group and individual activities to suit all age groups and interests. Non-motorised activities such as kayaking, windsurfing and catamaran sailing are complimentary. Motorised activities such as water skiing, parasailing, banana boating and fun tubes are available for an applicable charge.

At the PADI-licensed Dive Centre, a team of experienced, multilingual dive instructors are ready to explore the area's excellent dive sites with you. There is also a dedicated surf school with professional surf instructors, which offers escorted surf sessions and clinics for experienced surfers as well as lessons for beginners.

DIVING

Orientation dive

You are required to participate in an orientation dive before engaging in boat diving activities if you have not been diving within the last three months and/or have fewer than 30 logged dives. Orientation dives are conducted daily in the lagoon. Please present your

certification card and log book when you register for diving.

All divers are advised to refrain from diving 12 hours after international flights or 24 hours before travel by air including a seaplane. A medical questionnaire must be completed prior to your first dive at either one of our Four Seasons Maldives resorts. Depending on your responses to the questionnaire, you may be required to pass a complimentary medical examination with our doctor.

Diving for beginners

Discover scuba diving – Experience the thrill of diving under the close supervision of our PADI instructor. This three-hour course consists of a theory briefing and a confined water session up to 12 metres (40 feet). Participants in this course must be over 12 years old.

For guests who would like to complete the theory portion of certification in advance of their vacation, PADI offers an online eLearning course. Fee applies. View more details.

For certified divers

Morning dive – Every morning from 8:30 am to around 12:00 pm, our dive boats take you on a two-tank dive to explore two of our dive sites. Refreshments of fruit and water are served during surface intervals.

For advanced divers

Adventure diver course – This is a one-day, three-dive course that includes three adventure dives.

For children

Bubblemaker experience – Join us at the swimming pool as our team of experienced instructors guides you through the steps to exploring the underwater world. All participants must be physically fit and able to swim. The bubblemaker experience is for children between 8 and 12 years of age.

SURFING

Four Seasons Resort Kuda Huraa Surf School

Adopt an entire ocean lifestyle at our Surf School, run by professionals from Tropic Surf of Noosa, Australia. Learn in the pristine lagoon with courses for guests aged six and older, or let loose on six uncrowded quality breaks within a stone's throw. Enjoy easy take-offs and long rides in some of the world's most consistent and warmest swells. Then head to the Surf Shack to store your board, watch the latest surf movie or just hang out. The best waves occur all year round for beginners and from April to October for experienced surfers.

Top surf sites

Four Seasons Resort Maldives is located only a few minutes' boat ride from some of the best surf breaks, described below.

Sultans (Thamburudhoo Right) – Located on an uninhabited island on the eastern reef of North Malé Atoll, this is one of the most consistent waves of Malé Atoll, and never closes

out, even on the biggest swells. The takeoff is a steep outside peak called Phantoms, which slingshots into a very long, walled, super-fast section called the Pinnacles, over 1 metre (4 feet) high. All three sections can be thrilling tubes. Rides are 91–137 metres (298–449 feet).

Honky's (Thamburudhoo Left) – Adjacent to Sultans on the eastern reef of the North Malé Atoll, this break starts small and increases in size and intensity as it wraps 90 degrees around the island. A 1.8-metre (6-foot) wave on the takeoff ends up at least 2.4 metres (8 feet) on the end section, called Fred's Ledge. There are long rides and tubes through all sections – best on low tides unless the swell is huge. The best months for this wave are February, March and April (it is affected by strong currents in the southwest monsoon from May to October).

Chickens – Named after a poultry farm on the island, Chickens is located at Villingilimathi Huraa (Kuda Villingili), another uninhabited island on the eastern reef of North Malé Atoll. When conditions are perfect, it is a pleasant thin, peeling, racing lip.

Daily boat rides to surf breaks are available for the competent surfer. Your experience can also be recorded on video for posterity.

WATER SPORTS

Recreation and Water Sports Centre

Open daily from 8:00 am to 7:00 pm, the Recreation and Water Sports Centre offers a wide range of group and individual activities. Complimentary snorkels, masks, fins and non-motorised water-sports equipment – such as sailboats, kayaks, catamarans and state-of-the-art windsurfing gear – are available.

SNORKELLING

Introduction to snorkelling

Learn snorkelling techniques and how to use snorkelling equipment, all in the safe environment of the Resort's lagoon. 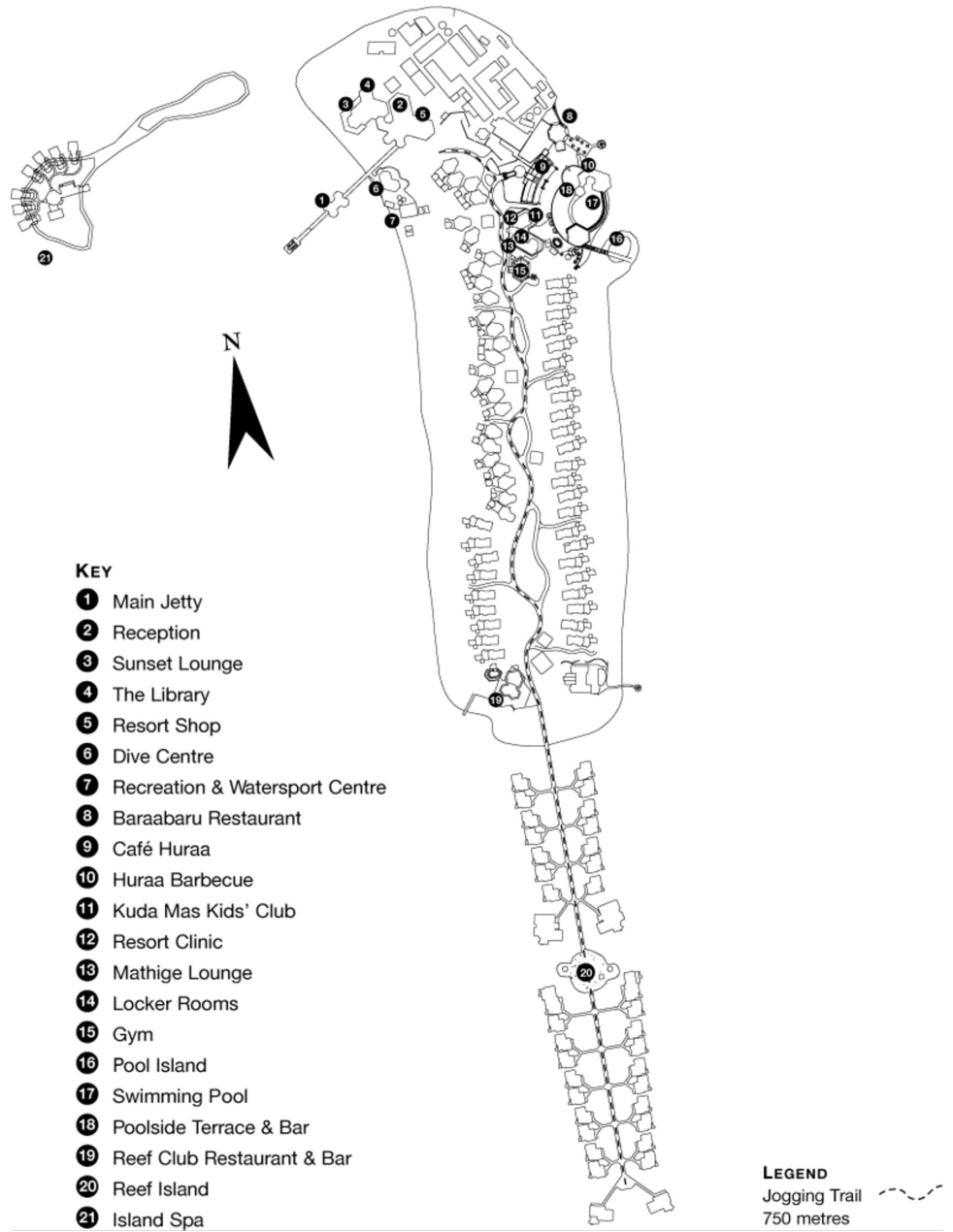
